Changes to Invitation for Bid:

Several questions have arisen that needed to be addressed and in response to those questions we have changed the due date to this invitation for bid.

1. **Bids will be received until 2:00 p.m.** Central Time on **Thursday, December 13, 2018**. at the office of the Memphis Housing Authority, 700 Adams Ave., Memphis, TN 38105, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Changes to Specifications:

- 1. Remove and destroy Bid Form and insert attached Bid Form Dated Revised 28, 2018, consisting of 6 pages.
- 2. Remove and destroy Section 26 32 16 Emergency Engine & Generator System and insert attached Emergency Engine & Generator System dated November 28, 2018, consisting of 12 pages.

Technical Questions and Answers:

- 1. Specification 26 32 13, Emergency Engine & Generator System? Note attached with revised Paragraph G
- 2. Specification 26 36 00-4, "Section 2.5 mentions bypass isolation switch...Is bypass isolation switch needed?.....
 - Bypass isolation switch is part of the ATS and included in the ATS.
- 3. The new enclosure at Venson Center shows a masonry enclosure. However, I do not see a call out for demo of the existing area?
 Contractor is responsible for all demolition and repair to existing pavement and
 - sidewalk surfaces as required for installation of the masonry wall and electrical equipment foundations. General Demolition notes can be seen on Sheet EO-14-1.
- 4. Note No 2
 - "Note D2 on sheet Ed1-14-1 of the Venson Center Generator project indicated the ATS will be furnished under the elevator project.
 - The ATS will be furnished as part of this Project.
